



SOFT-COATED WHEATEN TERRIER CLUB OF GB

OFFICIAL LIST OF PARENTS OF WHEATENS PROVEN TO HAVE RENAL DYSPLASIA

Whilst it is considered that Renal Dysplasia (RD) in the Soft-Coated Wheaten Terrier is inheritable, there is no clear agreement on the mode of inheritance. It must also be noted that there are other causes of kidney disease, including RD, that are caused by other external factors, rather than by genetic inheritance. A diagnosis for RD can only be confirmed following a post-mortem examination of the deceased dog's kidneys or by analysing a wedge biopsy taken from a living dog. There is currently no genetic/DNA test for RD.

Renal Dysplasia (RD) has been recognised as a cause of kidney failure & death in young Wheatens since the mid-1970s. It was well characterised by Professor Andrew Nash and colleagues in 1984. There is a familial and inherited basis to this condition, although the mode of inheritance has not been confirmed it is suspected to be autosomal recessive.
