#### **MPD (1)**

**1 Satherley's Silkcraft Perfect Symmetry (ai)**, apt name for this young man who is an excellent prospect for the future. Stood alone but stood out with his quality. Breed head of correct proportions, neck into correct strong forequarters, well balanced, good angulation, ideal size with abundant coat coming through, moved with ease around the ring. **BPIB**.

#### **JD (2)**

**1 Satherley & Wynter's Lakkas Yankee Sweet Silkcraft (Imp Swe) JW**, Quality Dog of good proportions. Flat skull well defined stop, correct dentition, well placed shoulders, deep well sprung rib, shown in good coat, moved freely around the ring.

**2 Lines-Barrett & Barrett's Abiqua Wild In My Blue Jeans**, Similar in shape to 1, nice head, well placed ear, correct eye and expression, short coupled, just preferred the coat of 1.

#### **PGD (3)**

**1 Mulholland & Howell's Denzilly Mr Trickster (ai)**. Typical Wheaten profile, well balanced with good angulation, correct forequarters with straight front. Deep chest, short loin, won the class on his front.

**2 Amel-Azizpour's Crofftysofty Hay Jude**. Well balanced dog good angulation and outline, dark expressive eye, correct dentition, well set on tail, slightly smaller than 1, just preferred the front of 1.

Masculine head, well defined stop, large black nose, correct eye and expression, strong neck into correct shoulders, short coupled with correct tailset, maintained his outline as he moved with ease around the ring **DCC**.

**2 Clarke's Flaxela Illuminati (ai) JW**. Powerful masculine head, dark eye, deep well sprung ribs, correct tailset, well-muscled hindquarters with good angulation, level topline, shown in excellent coat and condition, moved well both ways, unlucky to meet 1 in such good form **RDCC**

**2 Davies' Brynhir Betty Boop.** Liked her overall profile and balance, feminine head, dark eye, strong forequarters, good shoulder placement, level topline which she kept on the move.

**1 Satherley's Silkcroft Crystal Ball (ai).** Another eye catching Wheaten from this excellent litter of puppies, like peas in a pod very little to separate the three, typical wheaten profile, correct balance and angulation, good fore and hindquarters, shown in good condition and coat, moved with ease around the ring.
